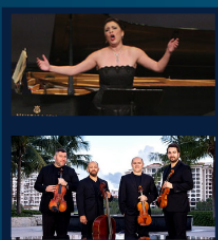

Al Cerulo, percussion

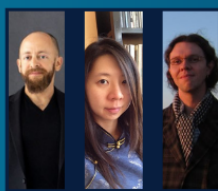
Renowned percussionist Al Cerulo performs a
